the argument continues the category itself internalizes ageist presumptions about older adults and is therefore inherently flawed and even harmful if certain older adults are because of physical or mental infirmities genuinely in need of an enhanced level of legal protection this entitlement should be conceptualized in terms of their disability older adults are not a distinct group but an arbitrarily delineated demographic category which contains within it any number of groups that are legitimately distinct for the purposes of legal theory the disabled women persons of colour aboriginal persons rich and poor etc indeed the artificial category of older adults may be seen as obfuscating submerging these more meaningful distinctions
